

Voluntary Annexation

Voluntary Annexation:

Property owners may petition the City to annex their property. The request for voluntary annexation requires at least 50% of the property owners' signatures in the area up for consideration.

Annexation Variables to Consider:

- Is the property contiguous to the full-purpose city limits?
- Is the petition for Voluntary Annexation from the majority of property owners?
- Learn what uses are allowed on your land if incorporated within the City.
- Learn about the review and decision making process.
- Who are the current service providers including the water purveyor
- Is the property located over the <u>Edwards Aquifer</u>, or within five miles within Camp Bullis.

Box 839966, San Antonio, Texas 78283.
