	A letter of transmission to the Planning Director of the City of San Antonio, P.O. Box 839966, San Antonio, Texas 78283-3966.	
	A petition signed by the landowners or persons having any interest in the property including the spouses if the property is co-owned. The petition must be acknowledged in the manner required for deeds by each person having an interest in the area and it must identify the property owned by each person signing as a petitioner. A notarized power of attorney is required if any person signs on behalf of another person. Appropriate corporate or partnership authorizations are required if a corporation or partnership is a petitioner	
	Payment of \$3,000 fee (set by Ordinance No. 101399)	
	Contact information for landowners including: Names, Mailing Addresses, Office/Daytime Telephone Numbers and E-mail Addresses
