This memorandum addresses the San Antonio Police Department's (SAPD) procedure on the release of audio and video recordings as they relate to a critical incident that occurred on June 4, 2024.

The following incident's audio and video recordings will not be released because it meets the following criteria in SAPD Procedure 410 Section 19: prohibited by law (for example, where the incident involves a juvenile) and/or where domestic violence is involved or suspected.

On June 4, 2024, officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of Babcock Rd for an assault in progress. A female victim called to report that she was being assaulted by her boyfriend. The suspect left the location but later forced his way into the apartment and pointed a gun at her while she was on the phone with the call taker. The suspect fired a single gunshot at the wall and the victim ran towards another room. When the officer arrived, he observed the suspect with a gun running after the victim. The officer discharged his firearm, striking the suspect. The suspect was transported to a local hospital where he was pronounced deceased. No one else was injured by gunfire.

As with all officer involved shootings, the District Attorney's Office is reviewing the incidents.
