Prequalified Public Art List Application Pointers



Do's:

- 1. Visit the <u>Department of Arts & Cultures Prequalified Public Art List page for important information!</u>
- 2. Apply on GO Smart.
- 3. Use the <u>Department of Arts & Cultures Prequalified Public Art List—Resources page.</u>
- 4. Apply if you have never been on the list or have been told your past application expired.
- Fill out the San Antonio Artist Registry, only if you are a San Antonio area-based artist.
- 6. **Continuously** update your San Antonio Artist Registry, website, and social media.
- 7. Contact Public Art Division staff about technical problems with the online application.
- 8. Apply for either the San Antonio Area or Non-San Antonio Area Application.

 Questions on residence can be found on the **Department of Arts & Culture's Prequalified Public Art List-Residency page**.
- 9. Ask a trusted friend or colleague to review your application prior to submission.
- 10. Consider all the categories for which you might be eligible. You can apply for both Artist and Support Services in the same application!
- 11. Use the "Save" button regularly throughout your application so you don't risk losing your progress.
- 12. Click the actual "submit" before the application closes.
- 13. Check your email to make sure you received a confirmation message once you have submitted your application.

Don'ts:

- 1. Apply if you are a performing artist that does not also create visual art.
- 2. Re-apply if you were not asked to—applications last for 3 years!
- 3. Re-apply if your portfolio or resume have changed—update your San Antonio Artist Registry, website, and social media instead.
- 4. Procrastinate! Remember, the San Antonio Artist Registry takes 3 days to be uploaded.
- 5. Leave the San Antonio Artist Registry link blank if you are a San Antonio Artist.
- 6. Contact Public Art staff to review your application / portfolio prior to the application deadline.
- 7. Assume that creating a profile on GO Smart is the same as submitting your application.
- 8. Contact City of <u>San Antonio City Council Members</u>, City of San Antonio employees, evaluation panelists, <u>San Antonio Arts Commissioners</u>, and <u>Public Art Committee</u> members about your application. If you have questions, please email <u>PublicArt@sanantonio.gov</u>
