

AGREED EXTENSION No. 2
TO TEMPORARILY AVOID STATUTORY IMPASSE
FOR PERIOD FROM JUNE 13, 2024 TO JUNE 28, 2024

The City of San Antonio and the International Association of Fire Fighters, Local 624, (referred to as "parties") mutually desire and agree to continue good faith negotiations and collectively bargain for up to fifteen (15) additional days. pursuant to the provisions of Texas Local Government Code Section 174.152(b) for the for the time period from June 13, 2024 to June 28, 2024.

The parties agree that impasse as defined by Texas Local Government Code Section 174.152(a) will not be reached in the current negotiation proceedings between the parties unless:

- (1) the parties fail to reach an agreement on a new CBA prior to June 28, 2024, or
- (2) the parties fail to enter into a mutually agreeable additional extension of time on or before June 28, 2024.


If neither of these conditions occur on or before June 28, 2024, the CBA negotiations will, by agreement of the parties, result in statutory impasse under Texas Local Government Code Chapter 174 on June 29, 2024. If neither of the above conditions occur on or before June 28, 2024, the parties' right to request arbitration under Texas Local Government Code Chapter 174 will commence on June 29, 2024, and expire not later than the fifth day following June 29, 2024, the date the parties will have reached statutory impasse.

Nothing in this agreement waives any right that any party has under Proposition C (Article XIV of the City of San Antonio Charter) and/or Texas Local Government Code Chapter 174.
