Critical Incidents: April 21 and April 30, 2024

This memorandum addresses the San Antonio Police Department's (SAPD) procedure on the release of audio and video recordings as they relate to two separate critical incidents that occurred on April 21, 2024 and April 30, 2024.

The following two incidents audio and video recordings will not be released because it meets the following criteria in SAPD Procedure 410 Section 19: prohibited by law (for example, where the incident involves a juvenile) and/or where domestic violence is involved or suspected.

- On April 21, 2024, officers were dispatched to a home on the 8600 block of Cheviot Heights for a report of an individual who had been intentionally struck by a vehicle. A felony warrant (Aggravated Assault with a Deadly Weapon) was issued for the suspect that lived with the victim. Officers later attempted to contact the suspect in his driveway when he intentionally struck two officers with his vehicle. One officer fired his weapon, striking the suspect. The suspect was pronounced deceased at the scene. Both officers suffered minor injuries.
- On April 30, 2024, officers responded to a welfare check at 8671 SW Loop 410 after family members reported they had not heard from the victim. Detectives entered the location and discovered a 33-year-old woman deceased with a gunshot wound. Through the course of the investigation, officers tracked the victim's rental vehicle to the 1800 block of Vance Jackson. The suspect, who is the victim's husband, began shooting at officers from inside the vehicle when officers attempted to contact him. Four officers returned fire, striking him. EMS made the location and pronounced the suspect deceased.

As with all officer involved shootings, the District Attorney's Office is reviewing the incidents.
